'Vaccinate to Operate'

30,000 Jobs for Our Nation!

(25th July, 2021) - The Trinidad and Tobago Manufacturers Association (TTMA) continues its drives to vaccinate the business community and the public. We are proud in accomplishing the administration of approximately 30,000 vaccines executed at eleven mass vaccination sites to-date. TTMA opened its vaccination site on 21st July, 2021 for 1st dose vaccinations to the public, the feedback has been overwhelmingly positive as many family and community members have visited the Divali Nagar site for their 1st doses as the ease of access to TTMA vaccine site location and the smooth and efficient operations lends to a pleasant experience.

President of the TTMA, Tricia Coosal stated, "TTMA is elated for the continued public-private partnership with the Ministry of Health and the Ministry of Trade & Industry which has now extended our vaccination sites to not only the business community but to the public at large."

Tricia Coosal detailed, "TTMA continues to deliver on its commitment to working with the Government to secure the safety of our nationals as the economy begins to be reopened. We began our vaccination drives focusing on the businesses community, however with the arrival of 800,000 vaccines on 13th July, 2021 TTMA can now accommodate expanded vaccination drives to include members of the public. Ms. Coosal highlighted, "The administration of 30,000 vaccines is indeed a milestone but we are not finished. We will continue the execution of a vaccination site at the Divali Nagar on Wednesday 28th July between the hours of 11am-4:30pm for 1st doses Sinopharm."
